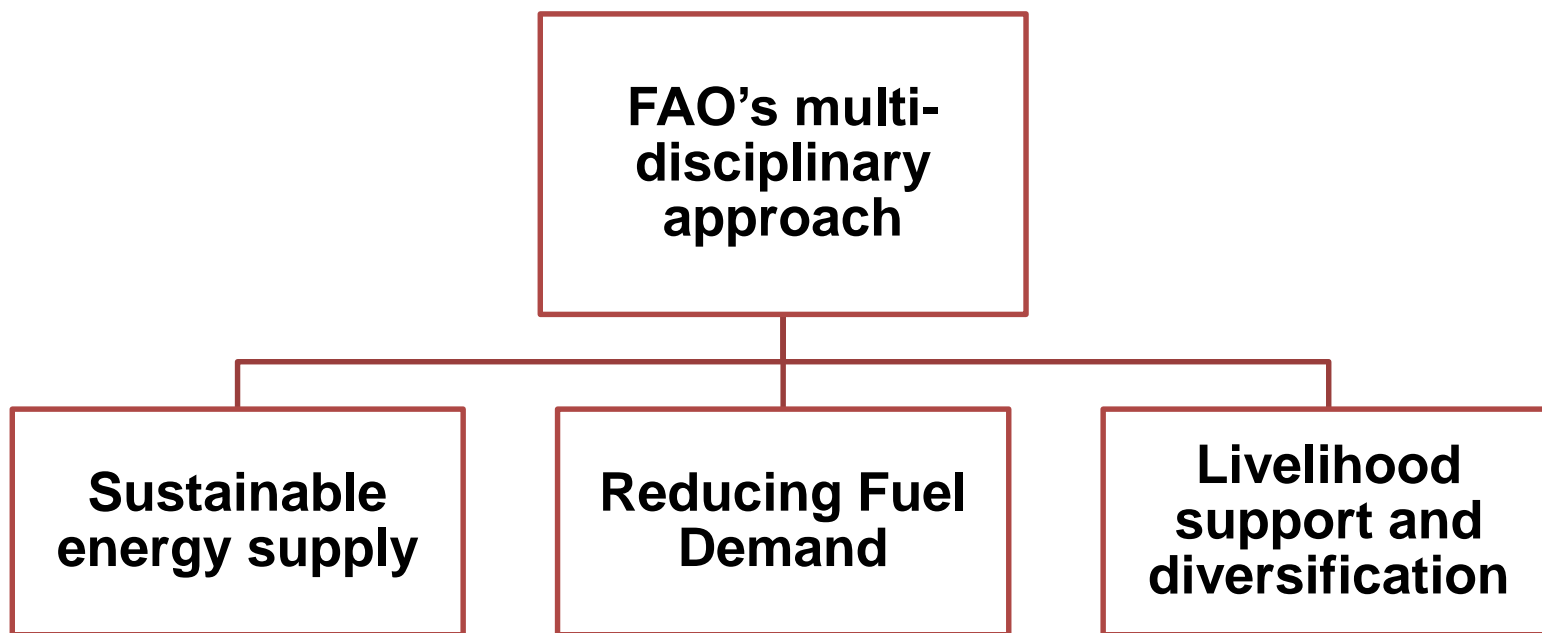

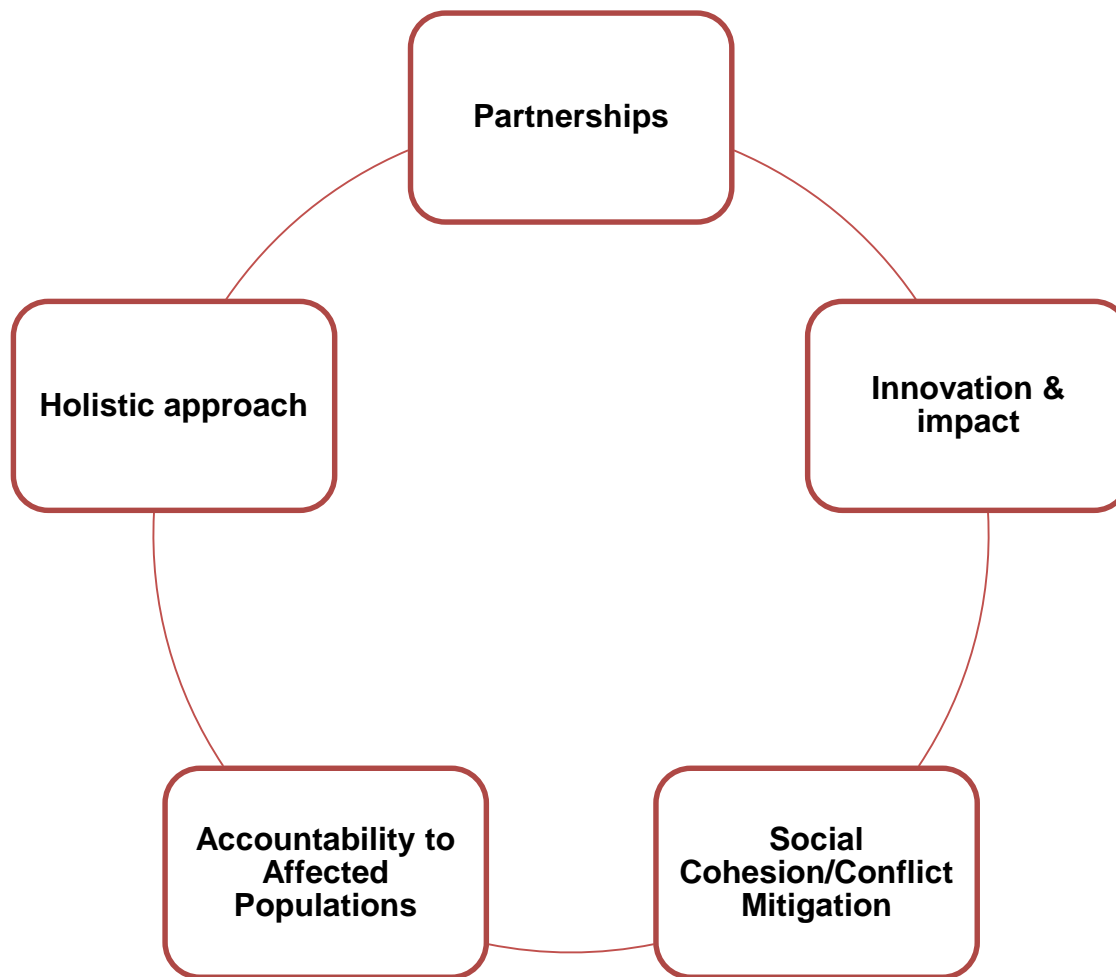




A glimpse of FAO SAFE activities
